Dear WRCS Community (and supporting congregations),

At the meeting with patrons this evening (4/29), those in attendance rallied in support of the school. One of our patrons has volunteered to organize a campaign to raise the funds needed to have WRCS open for another year or two. The Board feels this will allow time to strategically plan for our future with a vision and financial sustainability. The amount needed to be raised is \$1 million based on an enrollment of 80 or more students. \$500,000 needs to be raised no later than May 30. Once the \$500,000 is raised the Board will approach the School Council for reconsideration of the decision to close the School.

Pastor Howard will begin a class for persons wishing to explore church membership. We will also discuss the option of the Covenant Membership which is offered by HMC.
