Old Testament Prayers: Hannah's I Sam. 1:4-11; 2:1-10
July 21, 2019 HMC

On August 18 we will be having a "Corinthian Service" where you will be given the opportunity to share what is on your heart. The Worship Committee would like to use the sermon series on O.T. Prayers to give shape to the Corinthian Service. The bulletin inserts will provide you with ways to respond to the sermons, and then you are encouraged to use them on August 18.

- Hannah's prayer is birthed in the emotional pain of her life.
   Her prayer is recorded in chapter 2. Look for a sense of self-pity. Is there any self-centeredness?
- In chapter 1:9 a transition takes place in Hannah's life. How would you describe what has happened?
- Does Hannah's prayer remind you of Mary, the mother of Jesus prayer in Luke 1:46-55?
- Make a note of the way Hannah places God at the center of life in her prayer.
- It is harder to see Jesus in this prayer. Chapter 2:8 reminds us of Jesus who was led to the ash heap of Golgotha.
- Name one way this prayer can inform how you pray.
