### **Mennonite Central Committee Gaza Crisis Response**

MCC is providing emergency relief with existing partners in Gaza, distributing locally purchased food packages, hygiene items and bedding as well as cash transfers to families in need. We are also working to help children cope with the trauma.

**In the West Bank, partners are providing food assistance** and agricultural supplies and training for people who have been affected by the violence there. And in Southern Lebanon, MCC is providing emergency food for displaced people.

**MCC laments the violence and mourns all lives lost** in Palestine and Israel. We continue to advocate to the Canadian government, the U.S. government and the United Nations community to speak out and encourage an immediate ceasefire and safe paths for humanitarian aid, and to hold all parties to the same standard of international law.
