

Dave began his pastoral ministry in 1977 as part of a copastoral team at Blough Mennonite Church near Johnstown PA. In 1990, he became Executive Director at Laurel View Village, a continuing care retirement community. Then after 23 years he resigned from the Laurel View Village post to return to pastoral ministry when he became pastor at HMC for three years. In 2016 Allegheny Mennonite Conference called him to become conference minister and a pastor within the conference. He retired as pastor of Scottdale Mennonite Church in 2023 and from his conference minister role in 2024.

Dave's spouse, Becky, passed two years ago after a long battle with cancer. He lives near Johnstown and has nine grandchildren. He enjoys gardening, biking and rooting for the lowly Pittsburgh Pirates.

He has been looking forward to coming out of retirement to rejoin the congregation at Huntington.
